### 1. CILT International Council Meeting 2010 in Malta

As announced, the 2010 International Council Meeting will be held in Malta between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> of May. In this e-circular, we are attaching the **ICM 2010 draft programme**. The programme is expected to be finalized very shortly.

In addition, we are enclosing information on **how to apply for a visa for Malta**. The process is time consuming and we encourage participants **to apply at least two months in advance prior to departing for Malta**. We will provide with all the necessary documentation required to assist delegates in their visa application process.

Participants from EU states, Singapore, Malaysia, Australia and New Zealand do not need a visa to travel to Malta. Applications are to be made in the country of residence of the delegates. If your country is not included in the attached lists, kindly contact the undersigned for further information.
